The Reno National Championship Air Races, the only place in the World where you can see five days of REAL AIR RACING by six classes of aircraft up close and personal. The Air Races have been run since 1964 near Reno and are currently held at Reno Stead Field, about eight miles North of Reno.

The next National Championship Air Races & Air Show will take place at Reno Stead Field Wednesday through Sunday, 13 - 17 September 2006.

Race aircraft in the Unlimited Class reach speeds of over 500 mph - by far the fastest-moving machines in motorsports! The event also includes a world-class air show featuring including the USAF Thunderbirds, top aerobatic performers, military and civil flight demonstrations, and a large display of static aircraft. In addition to enjoying all of the flying, you can visit the pits and watch race teams work on their aircraft, browse any of the hundreds of participating vendors' booths, and enjoy a wide variety of food and beverages and other amenities during your visit.
