Turn right (east) onto 7th STREET for about 1 mile to KLONDIKE. Turn left (north) to the school (5890 KLONDIKE DR)

From 395 south bound, take the N. MCCARRAN BLVD exit. Turn left onto CLEAR ACRE LANE. CLEAR ACRE becomes SUN VALLEY DRIVE. Continue north on SUN VALLEY DRIVE to 7th STREET. Turn right (east) onto 7th STREET for about 1 mile to KLONDIKE. Turn left (north) to the school (5890 KLONDIKE DR)
