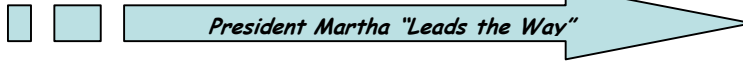

Your board awarded this scholarship based on her letter, which I quote below.

“At the NSLC I will have the opportunity to participate in leadership development workshops where I will develop skills including conflict resolution. In addition, I will participate in lectures and workshops that will give me a better understanding of medicine and healthcare. I have developed an interest in this field since I was 13 because I visit my extended family Mexico during summer break and have volunteered all summer at children’s hospital for the extremely poor. The experiences I have had at this hospital have made me want to help those who do not have healthcare and are suffering.

This young lady is known as Pia because her mother’s first name is also Maria. Her mother is an American citizen. Pia’s goals include becoming a U. S. citizen and a “compassionate doctor that will help people in the community”.

:I am very grateful to be able to live legally in the United States and have access to a good education. I will apply for citizenship next year. I feel that because I have been so fortunate in having so many educational opportunities that I

have a moral obligation to give back to the community.”

“I have recently a Latino Club with my brother to encourage Latino students to stay in school and mentor other students who are struggling. My brother and I have recently started tutoring elementary children who are learning English at a Title I charter school.”

Sounds like a future Rotarian to me. Pia will be invited to speak to our club on her return from NSLC.

Reno PD K-9 Unit Officers

The Reno Police Department canine unit was formed in 1962. The unit currently consists of 5 dogs and 6 police officer handlers. A sixth dog is assigned to a detective unit and also works with the bomb squad. The dogs and their police officer handlers are trained to work as a team. The dogs track and help apprehend suspects, protect their officer handlers, search for controlled substances, search buildings, search for explosives, and locate lost persons. The canine team is an instrumental part of RPD field operations and they conduct numerous public education demonstrations in addition to their regular duties.
